The **Instituto Gulbenkian de Ciência (IGC)** is looking for a highly motivated and ambitious person to implement citizen science and citizen consultation activities within the frame of *Cidadania Ativa* program, including both the Citizen Science and the Citizens Assembly initiatives, funded by the Oeiras City Hall.

The Active Citizenship Program, *Ciência + Cidadã*, is a partnership between IGC, the Instituto de Tecnologia Química e Biológica da Universidade NOVA and the Oeiras City Hall. The program's mission is to make science and the scientific process open and accessible to everyone and promote society's participation in science.

ROLE(s):

- Design and propose long term strategies for citizen science and community engagement;
- Design, develop and coordinate a multidisciplinary approach to citizen science initiatives;
- Engage and coordinate different stakeholders (scientists, schools, citizens, etc.);
- Recruit, motivate and coordinate volunteers;
- Coordinating and promoting different scientific institutions collaboration in citizen science initiatives for the local community;
- Implement public consultation strategies on science and society topics;
- Apply for funding and support fundraising initiatives;
- Assess Impact of initiatives.

PROFILE:

- PhD in any scientific domain;
- 5-year professional experience in science communication, science education or citizen science;
- Leadership and organisational skills;
- Excellent writing and oral communication skills;
- Intercultural skills and high capacity to work in and lead teams;
- Fluency in Portuguese and English.

Preference may be given to candidates who have experience in:

- Ecology or environmental-based projects;

- Teaching and education;
- Working with different stakeholders, particularly teachers and students;
- Coordinating science education or community engagement projects;
- Impact assessment tools.

WE OFFER:

- A 12 month working contract, with possibility of renewal (the contract duration is dependent on the transference of the project to an Association under the coordination of the Municipality of Oeiras and their partners and, upon expiration, a new contract will be settled with the Association)
- Competitive salary depending on candidate level of expertise
- Continuous training
